# AHA!!!

"When the Wise Men saw the star, they rejoiced exceedingly with great joy."

Matthew 2:10

Epiphany comes from the Greek, meaning "to show forth," "to manifest," "an appearance." Today, in English, we might say an "epiphany" is an "aha!" moment.

We marvel at all the "aha!" moments for the Wise Men. First was the Star. The Wise Men knew from their astronomy that this was no ordinary star. Second, they knew by God's inspiration that this extraordinary star heralded the birth of a great king. Third, they found the baby king in a manger in a stable in Bethlehem, not Jerusalem, the son of humble parents. Their fourth "aha!" moment must have been receiving God's warning in a dream not to return to evil King Herod. That's a lot of epiphanies!

What about our "aha!" moments today? First would be our faith about this baby king. Do you remember when you first began to understand that Christmas was more than presents? Maybe you remember when you first began to appreciate the eternal significance of God's great gift. Despite ongoing human sinfulness, there really is "Peace on Earth": Eternal Salvation for all who believe! Despite the seeming futility of this life, there really is a "Meaning of Life": sharing Jesus' Salvation with all who have yet to hear. That's a lot of epiphanies!

We will celebrate pew communion this month on January  $2^{nd}$ , and remember Jesus' sacrifice of love, forgiveness, and salvation.




Soon we will be resuming scheduled nursery care during worship.


ust adjacent to La Paz, Bolivia, is El Alto, the second-largest and fastest-growing urban center in Bolivia. Twelve-year-old Lorena lives in El Alto with her mother and two younger sisters. They are a migrant Aymara family, and Lorena's mother works long hours. Like many other migrants in the region. Lorena's mother didn't have time to help Lorena or her sisters with their schoolwork if they struggled to complete it. Lorena needed help.

Lorena found out about Mi Esperanza School Support Center, a project of the Iglesia Evangélica Luterana Boliviana (Evangelical Lutheran Church in Bolivia). by chance. Passing by it one day, she and her mom saw a poster on the door, offering children help with their schoolwork.

Supported in part by ELCA World Hunger, the center is dedicated to serving migrant Aymara families such and educational needs. Ensuring students receive sufficient education is a key way communities can equip them for security against hunger and poverty in the long term.

The center offers support in math, spelling, language and other subjects in which students may be falling behind. It also offers workshops for mothers, giving them the tools to develop their skills and improve their families' living conditions.

Lorena found help at the center: help with her schoolwork, school supplies and spiritual guidance. Lorena says, "I must not tire of practicing the values I have learned in my life, knowing that I must love my neighbor as myself and that God has a purpose for me."





You support programs, including education and vocational training, that help people facing hunger, homelessness and other challenges to get jobs. increase their earning potential and break the cycle of poverty for good.




2022 Officers will be elected at a special Council meeting prior to the January meeting. Results will be in the February News from the Pews.




