A Word From The Pastor...

It's wonderful all the ministries and fellowship events and activities that we're sharing at St. John's. Pentecost Holy Communion, Holy Baptism, Confirmation, Recognitions, Sunday School Appreciation Breakfast, Choir Banquet, Father's Day, Hoagie Sale, Knoebel's, Daybreak, Iron Pigs, and more. And that's just in June!

Yes, all is great at St. John's, except for our weekly offerings. I'll let Financial Secretary Ondie Neifert share where we are as a congregation:

There are concerns as to our current financial status. Offerings are \$5100.00 lower than they were at this time last year. This is concerning because we are heading into the summer season when offerings tend to be lower as people take time off for vacations and summer activities. Also, our expenses are increasing as we return to our full schedule.

So far we have been able to pay all of our bills including our benevolence obligations. We took advantage of the 2% discount on our local taxes for the church and parsonage, but we are unable to do the same for the rental property taxes. Hopefully we will be able to pay them by the end of June so that we do not incur a penalty.

Please continue to consider your church's financial needs. Your offerings are greatly appreciated and we thank you very much for your ongoing support!







Mark your calendars for the week of July 18th!



Fresh Peach Cobbler

½ cup butter, melted 2 large peaches, peeled and sliced 1 pinch ground nutmeg 1½ cups sugar, divided 1 cup all-purpose flour 2 tsp. baking powder

1/4 tsp. salt ½ tsp cinnamon 34 cup milk

Preheat oven to 375°

Pour butter into an 8-inch square baking dish. Combine peaches and 3/4 cup sugar in a bowl.

Whisk flour, remaining sugar, baking powder, salt, nutmeg, and cinnamon together in t bowl. Stir in milk just until batter is combined. Pour batter over butter and top with peaches.


Bake until the cobbler is golden brown, 45 to 50 minutes.

NOTE: This can also be made with a pint of blueberries in place of the peaches.
