Certainly we will bump into each other occasionally, but anything to do with St. John's must be off-limits, so that you can effectively move forward into the pastoral transition. This will also give your new Pastor total freedom from "the ghost of pastor past."

If all of the above sounds a bit clinical and cold, allow me to express the warmth that I really want to share. Only after our Lord Jesus Christ and my family, you are all the best! Surely we had some tough times, but by the Grace of God, our ministry together effectively brought Salvation in Christ to a whole generation in Coplay, Whitehall, and beyond. That's huge! In short, then, I shall miss all of you very, very much.

- ½ tsp. seasoned salt

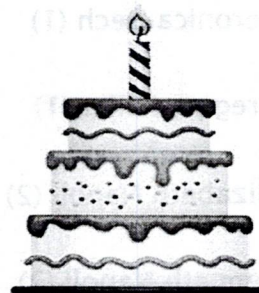
Mix all ingredients together.

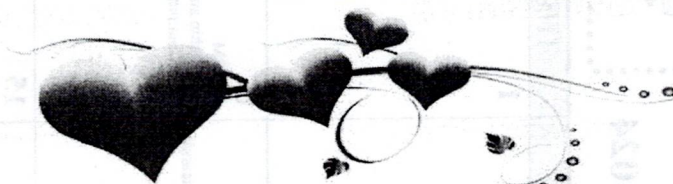


