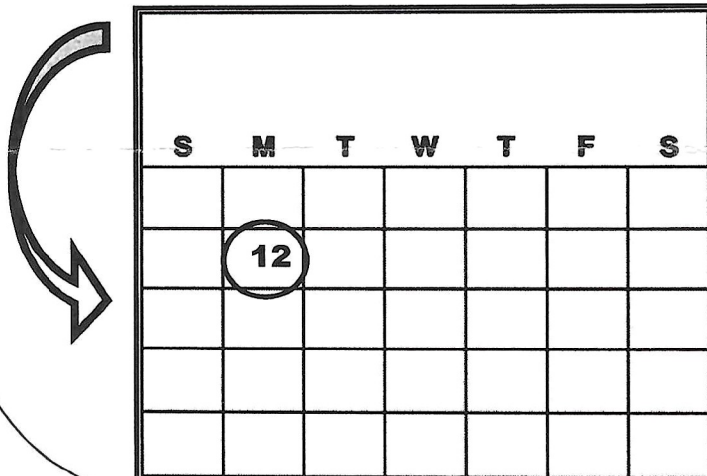

## Do you have a "standing order" for altar flowers?

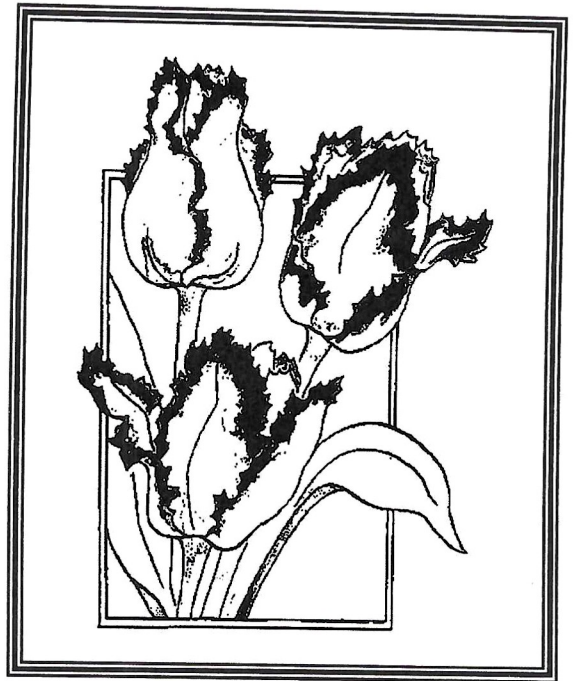
If you have a standing order for altar flowers, please check with me so we can be sure you have the Sunday(s) you want.

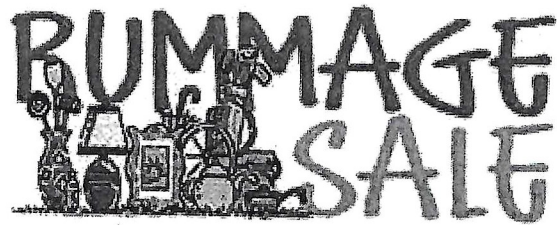
# FIRST ANNUAL ST. JOHN'S LUTHERAN CHURCH RUMMAGE SALE

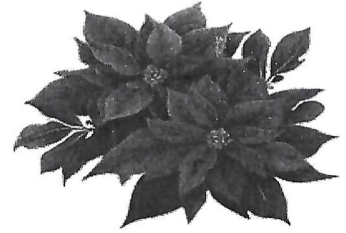

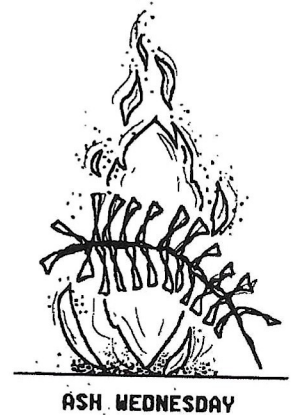




# ASH WEDNESDAY

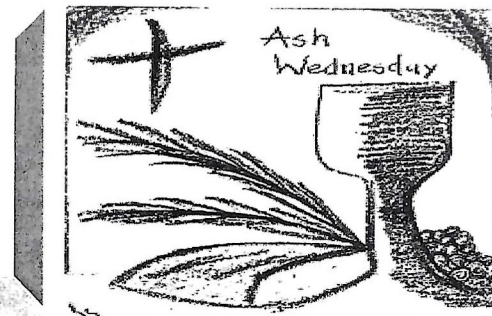

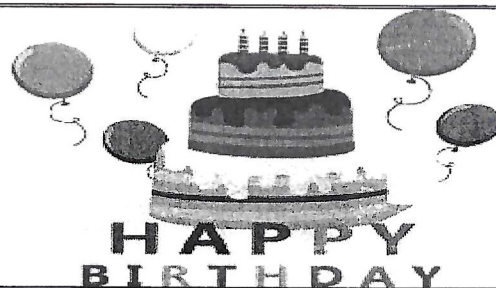

### PIEROGI CASSEROLE

12 oz. bacon	1 bag of Colby Jack cheese
1 box of lasagna noodles	½ stick butter
3 lbs. potatoes	1 cup milk
1 onion	1 tsp. garlic powder
1 bag of Cheddar cheese	1 tsp. black pepper

1. Cook the potatoes and mash them. Add milk and butter. Add ½ cup cheddar cheese. Add garlic powder and black pepper. Set aside.
  2. Cut up bacon and fry with onion.
  3. Cook noodles and drain.
  4. Using a 9 x 13 pan, start a layer of noodles, layer of mashed potatoes, next layer of bacon and onions, then sprinkle cheese on top.
  5. Keep layering til you use all ingredients.
  6. Put on top layer of noodles the left over cheese.
  7. Bake in oven, covered with foil at 350 degrees for 30 minutes.
  8. Remove foil and bake for another 15 minutes.

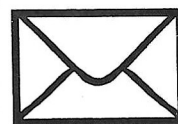


