
59th Annual Coplay Community Thanksgiving Service

Please join us for the Sunday School's Christmas program on Sunday, December 21st, during the 10:30 AM worship service.




Sing Christmas Carols to our shut-ins!




...and the Unhanging of the Greens



½ cup green colored sugar

5. Sprinkle nuts on top, pressing down lightly.

6. Bake in preheated oven at 350 for 30 minutes.


7. Cut in small squares and serve warm.
