

VETERANS DAY






58th Annual Coplay Community Thanksgiving Service

CAN YOU HELP WITH GIFTS?



APPLE CAKE

2 cups apples, peeled and chopped

1 cup sugar

1 ½ cups flour 1 tsp. baking soda

1/2 tsp. salt

1. Add sugar to apples, let sit for 10 minutes.

2. Sift together the dry ingredients.

3. Melt the butter and cool.

4. Add the egg to the apple mixture.

5. Combine wet and dry ingredients.

6. Fold in the nuts.

Pour into greased 8 in. square pan. Bake at 350 degrees for 50 minutes.

Cool and sprinkle with powdered sugar.
